

A Bill to Require U.S. Civics Education

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

Section 1. In order to vote in the U.S Presidential Election, citizens will be required to complete a civics education course that will amount to 30 hours.

Section 2.

- A. "Civics Education" shall be defined as an educational course that will inform citizens on the basics of the U.S government.
- B. The civics education will detail the basics of the functions of government and the rights of citizens.

Section 3. The Department of Education shall oversee the implementation of this bill.

Section 4. This bill shall be fully implemented prior September 2018.

Section 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
