

# A Bill to Comprehensively Reform Drug Policy

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

**SECTION 1.** Seeing the disjointed and unjust drug policy occurring within different state borders, this legislation seeks to streamline and reform drug policy on a federal level.

- A) Use of recreational Marijuana will be legalized in all fifty states. State licensed marijuana dispensaries are authorized to sell Marijuana for recreational use only.
- B) Purely informal education regarding drug use will be established by a committee of senators. The information will be integrated into public high schools.
- C) The Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) will be disbanded. The multi billion dollar budget will be invested into the means of drug education for the one thousand poorest districts in the United States of America.

**SECTION 2.** The educational curriculum will consist of the scientifically backed impacts drugs have on the body.

“Integrated into public high schools” shall be defined as adding drug education into high school daily life, and not as reforming high school education around the education of drugs.

**SECTION 3.** The Departments of Justice and Education will oversee the implementation. The FDA will regulate marijuana dispensaries.

**SECTION 4.** Will be put into action January 1, 2022

**SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
