

A Bill to Repeal the Three Strikes Rule.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- SECTION 1.** WE WILL NO LONGER USE THE THREE STRIKES RULE FOR FEDERAL CRIMES.
- SECTION 2.** THE THREE STRIKES RULE IS DEFINED AS ANY STATUTE THAT IMPOSES HARSHER SENTENCES ON HABITUAL OFFENDERS WHO ARE PREVIOUSLY CONVICTED OF TWO PRIOR SERIOUS CRIMINAL OFFENSES AND THEN COMMIT A THIRD.
- SECTION 3.** THIS BILL SHALL BE IMPLEMENTED BY THE JUSTICE DEPARTMENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA'S GOVERNMENT.
- SECTION 4.** THIS BILL SHOULD BE IMPLEMENTED WITHIN 90 DAYS OF BILL PASSAGE.
