

A Bill to Invest in Africa's Education System

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1. The United States will allocate 50 billion dollars to the improvement and advancement of African education.

SECTION 2. African education includes aid towards infrastructure, hiring qualified teachers, educational technology, and other necessities.

SECTION 3. The Department of State and the Department of Education will be responsible for providing funding and working with DoE approved Non-Governmental Organizations (NGO's) in Africa.

SECTION 4. Will be put into action January 1, 2020

SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
