

A Bill to Cease Usage of Opiate in Hospitals to Minimize Opiate Addiction

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- 1 **SECTION 1.** All opiate prescription and usage will be halted.
- 2 **SECTION 2.** An opiate is any drug containing opium or its derivatives.
- 3 **SECTION 3.** The Center for Disease Control and the Drug Enforcement Agency will
- 4 enforce this bill.
- 5 A. Any doctor who prescribes or makes use of opiates will lose their
- 6 medical license.
- 7 B. Alternatives to opiates that could be practiced for pain relief include
- 8 Acetaminophen, Nonsteroidal Anti-Inflammatory Drugs (NSAIDs),
- 9 Cortisosteroids, Serotonin and Norephinephrine Reuptake Inhibitors,
- 10 Neurostimulators, Anticonvulsants, Physical Therapy, Acupuncture,
- 11 Chiropractic care and Exercise.
- 12 C. There will be no new opiate prescriptions immediately upon the
- 13 passing of this bill.
- 14 **SECTION 4.** This bill will go into full effect on January 1st, 2018.
- 15 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
