

A Bill to Abolish Bail

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1. Bail shall hereby be abolished at all levels of government.

SECTION 2. Bail shall be defined as security, such as cash, a bond, or property, pledged or given to a court by or on behalf of one accused of committing a crime, to obtain release from incarceration and to ensure the person's future appearance in court when required during the criminal proceeding.

SECTION 3. The US Department of Justice will be responsible for making this change and ensuring all involved comply.

SECTION 4. Will be put into action January 1, 2020

SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
