

The American Addiction Act

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1. Opioid and Opiate prescription and usage shall be halted.

SECTION 2. An Opiate/Opioid is any drug containing opium or its derivatives.

SECTION 3. The Food and Drug Administration, Drug Enforcement Agency, and Federation of State Medical Boards shall oversee the implementation of this act.

- A. Any doctor who prescribes or makes use of opiates/opioids will lose their medical license.
- B. Alternatives to Opiates/Opioids that could be practiced for pain relief include Acetaminophen, Nonsteroidal Anti-Inflammatory Drugs (NSAIDs), Corticosteroids, Serotonin and Norepinephrine Reuptake Inhibitors, Neurostimulators, Anticonvulsants, Physical Therapy, Acupuncture, chiropractic care and exercise.

SECTION 4. This act shall go into full effect on January 1st, 2019.

SECTION 5. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
