

# The Renew DACA Act

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

**SECTION 1.** The United States shall hereby renew The Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals policy for 10 years.

**SECTION 2.** DACA is an immigration policy calling for deferred action for certain undocumented young people who came to the U.S. as children. DACA allows young people who were brought illegally to the United States as children, and who meet several key criteria to be considered for temporary relief from deportation or from being placed in removal proceedings. .

**SECTION 3.** The U.S. Department of Homeland Security shall be responsible for implementing and conducting activities pursuant to this act.

**SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect immediately upon passage.

**SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
