11		homelessness over the course of a year; and
12	WHEREAS,	There is no government entity dedicated to bringing relief to the homeless
13		population; now, therefore, be it

15	RESOLVED,	By the Congress here assembled that. A government agency within the
16		Department of Urban Housing and Development be created to help
17		alleviate the growing homeless crisis.
